



# HELP DIVERT PVC CABLE SCRAP FROM LANDFILL



The PVC industry supports diverting PVC cable from landfill.

Stripped PVC cable can be reprocessed into many useful products.



PVC wire and cable insulation can be collected and recycled. The cable is first stripped of its PVC insulation by cable stripping companies, who recover the metal contents of the cable. The insulation is then sent to PVC recyclers as stripping or granulates. It is then purified to remove any contaminants, washed, cooled and compounded. Finally it is melted and used to process new products.

## Recycled PVC scrap can be made into many useful products including:

- Garden hose
- Sound proof panels
- Bollard bases
- Drain pipes
- mats and floor coverings
